#### HOW TO FORM THAT COMMITTEE

The men of a Field Artillery (15th) Unit at Balcombe recently felt that their leave arrangements were unjust, fatigues were unevenly distributed, their messing equipment was poor and they strongly resented the manner in which they were addressed by their officers.

One man formed a committee of six around him to discuss ways and means of improving their conditions. They listed their grievances, and the necessary reforms, and put them to the men, who decided to back them to the limit. The committee asked to be allowed to read a copy of Australian Military Regulations and Orders, but this was refused.

They decided to strike if their demands were not met. Faced with this decision, the officers had no alternative but to concede the concessions asked. The committee of six now have weekly meetings,

and discuss any grievances or any subject concerning the welfare of the men. If necessary a spokesman is appointed to approach the authorities. Because of his solid backing the spokesman is sure of a good hearing.

The soldiers committee also successfully organised a cuchre tourfiament for prizes donated by their
officers, who have also advanced
money to buy extra messing equipment. Officers and men approve
of the scheme, and since it has
been in operation there have been
no complaints.

Committees of the privates in ever battalion should be formed, not on to look after the welfare of the men, but to assist in the plan-vning of modern and efficient methods of training.

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## FIVE REASONS FOR OPENING A FRONT IN EUROPE

- l, Hitler, as a result of his needs on the Eastern Front, especially with his present blitz on Moscow has been forced to withdraw all but eight divisions of his forces in occupied Europe, nearly all his planes and tanks.
- 2. This withdrawal has meant that second and third class troops have been substituted, but nowhere near the same numbers. There has been no replacement of equipment, however.
- 3. The withdrawal of so many troops and so much equipment has given Britain a superiority in men and materials over Hitler's forces, such as we may never have again.

- 4. Britain's war aims, which are to defeat Hitler and free the peoples of Europe, can only be accomplished by defeating Hitler on the continent, and no better opportunity will present itself than doing that job now.
- 5. That an invasion of Europe would be the signal for wide-spread support amongst the enslaved people for the invading forces and against the Nazi task masters.
